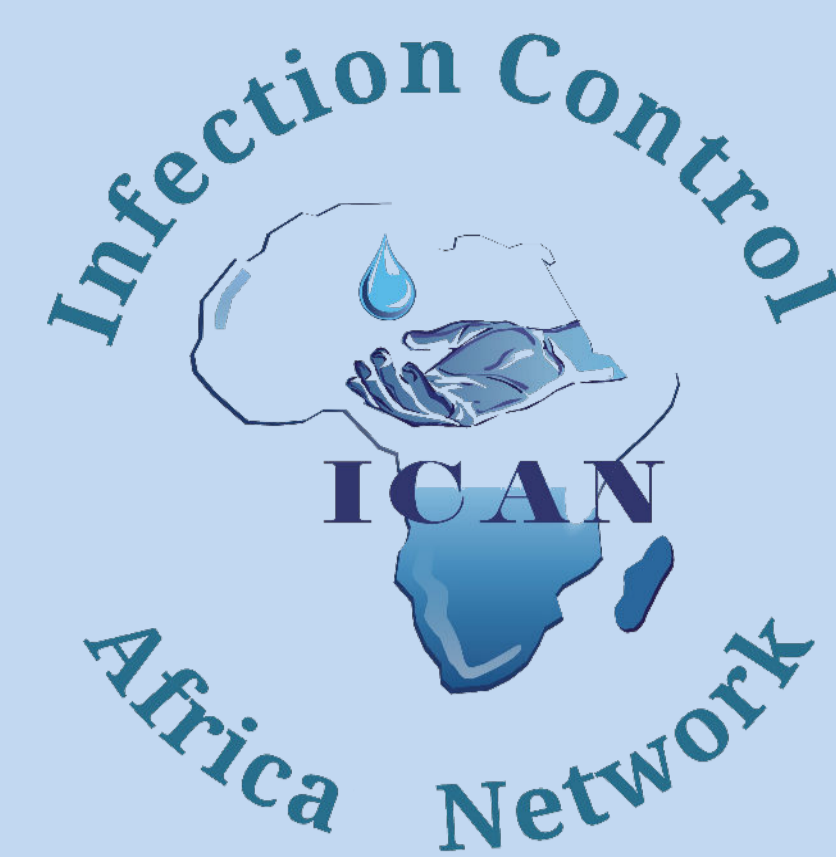

Course Overview

- The course aims at developing and improving the skills and abilities of SSD workers to deal competently with decontamination and sterilization in their everyday jobs.
- The course provides all levels of SSD workers with a basic understanding of practice and procedure.
- The course serves as an introduction to sterile services and clarifies misconceptions in the workplace.
